

Land of the Leaders ET Challenge

The Land of the Leaders ET Challenge will consist of four race series to be held at each NHRA Northwest Division Member Track. Racers will compete at their local track and will not be required to travel. Each contestant will be required to be signed up for track points and have an NHRA competition number. Champions will be crowned in Super Pro, Pro and Sportsman. Each category champion will receive a Champions jacket and Wally.

Program Guidelines

- ❖ Four races series to be held at each member track on dates specified by the member track. Renegade Raceway dates: April 28, June 1, July 6 and August 3.
- ❖ Racer must be signed up for track points program and have a current NHRA Competition Number in the ET category for Super Pro, Pro and Sportsman.
- ❖ Racer may compete in this program at more than one member track, but points will be awarded per track.
- ❖ Points will be awarded by the Northwest Division office as follows:
 - Thirty three (33) car minimum field size (six rounds): Winner – 95 points, Runner up – 72 points, Semi finalist – 53 points, Quarter finalist – 42 points, Eighth finalist – 31 points.
 - Seventeen (17) car minimum field size (five rounds): Winner – 85 points, Runner up – 64 points, Semi finalist – 43 points, Quarter finalist – 32 points.
 - Nine (9) car minimum field size (four rounds): Winner – 85 points, Runner up – 64 points, Semi finalist – 43 points.
 - Five (5) car minimum field size (three rounds): Winner – 75 points, Runner up – 54 points.
 - Three (3) car minimum field size (two rounds): Winner – 65 points, Runner up – 44 points.
- ❖ In the event of a tie, the procedure to break tie will be: 1) Driver with most rounds won at scored events, 2) Tied competitors will face off at the Summit Northwest Division Finals with winner being crowned the 2012 Land of the Leaders ET Challenge Champion.
- ❖ Points will be kept solely by, and at the discretion of, the Northwest Division office.
